1 Ayukawa Garden

A fresh, salty sea breeze blows over the beautiful scenery of Ayukawa Garden. You can camp here, and there are also fishing spots.



2 Shurei Shrine

At the peak of the mountain stands a shrine that the locals call "Otake-san". You can look out over the townscape of Ayukawa from here.



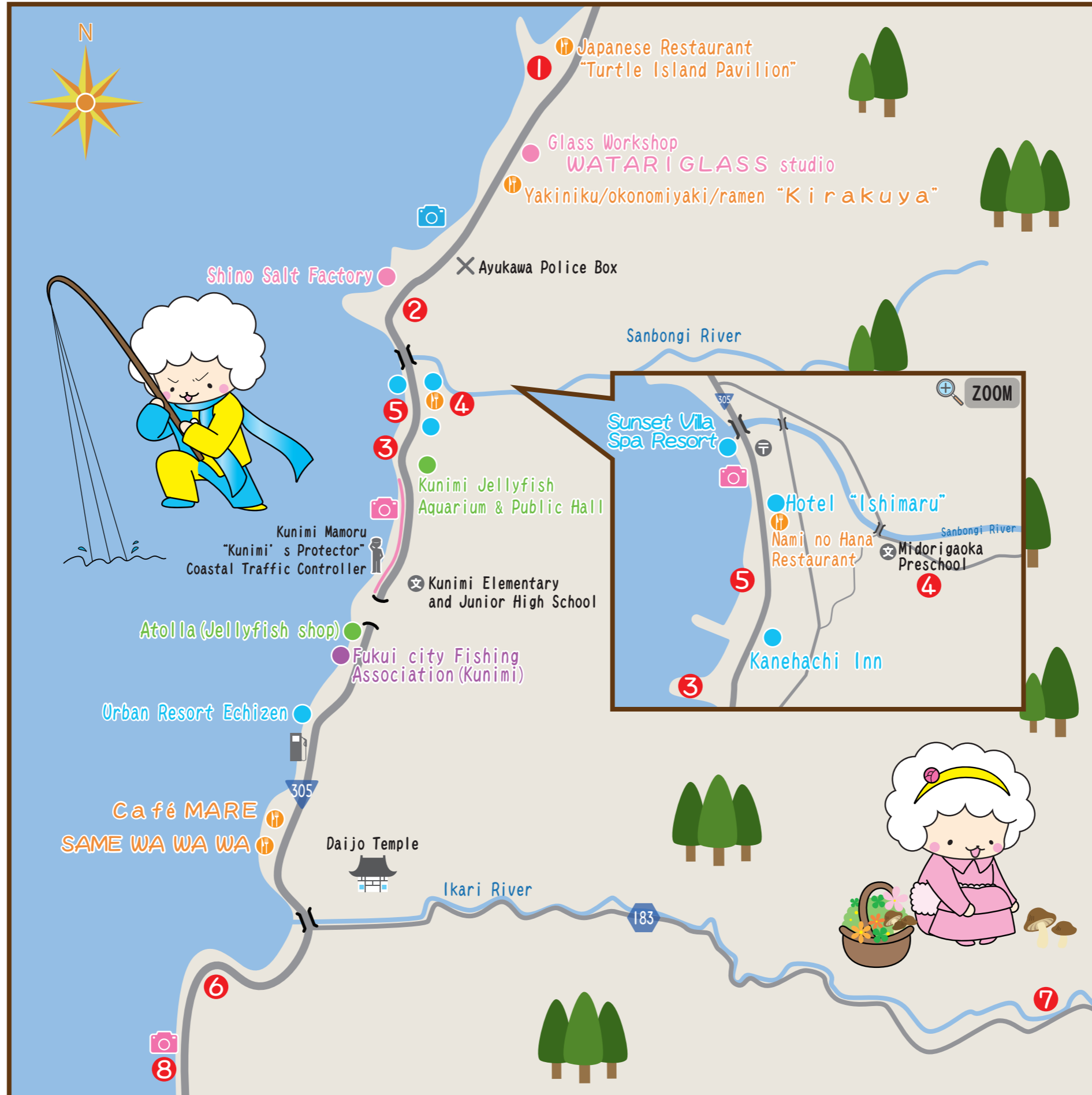
3 Nishinomiya Ebisu Shrine

You can see the ocean spreading out from the rear of this shrine. The sunset viewed from here is especially beautiful. It's even been used in movie scenes!



4 Kamono Shrine

The date of construction is a mystery. According to legends, it was once recorded in shrine registries as a large shrine endowed with at least 80 stones by Shinto priests, and nearby villages revered it as the home of several gods.

5 Ayukawa Stone Beach

7 Gotaishi Waterfall

It's said that once upon a time, five princes came here for ascetic training. Thus, the waterfall was called Gotaishinotaki, or "Waterfall of the Five Crown Princes."



8 Brave Man's Washing Rock

They say the brave and honorable do their laundry here. The rocks are famously rough, and fossils can be found here too.
